OBVERSE:

**BACK TO MAGINOT**

**Adolf Hitler: "No German soldier without concrete protection".**

*Picture of the entrance to one of the big Maginot forts.*

Caption:

"This great edifice of French engineering talent is a work of peace. For by making the frontiers of France impassable, they are also acting as a warning against any possible aggressor."

(War Minister Maginot in 1930, about the fortifications constructed by him.)

*Picture of Hitler inspecting smashed Maginot line.*

Caption:

**Maginot line the end of a symbol.**

"The Maginot line was the symbol of the fear of a people that had become weak."

(*Völkischer Beobachter*, 1940.)

"A system of concrete pillboxes, of tank traps, and minefields run along the entire coast in order to bar the way against any intruder. These Westwall-like constructions consist of a system of fortifications which alone, through their strength, warn against any attack."

(D.N.B., 1943).

REVERSE:

Picture of British bombers attacking the Ruhr.

Caption: "...and behind the Atlantic Wall".

The RAF is now stronger than the German and Italian airforces together. American aircraft production is greater than that of Germany, Italy, and Japan together.

The Luftwaffe dropped 450 tons of bombs in its heaviest attack on London. The RAF, in its great attacks on Essen and Berlin, dropped 1,000 tons of bombs in one night, in an attack on Duisburg over 1,300 tons.
